2.0 MEMBERSHIP

3.0 EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

The following are the main events and the activities that has been carried out and planned for the year 2014 - 2015.

3.1 ROUNDTABLE ON “AFFORDABLE HOUSING – ISSUES AND CHALLENGES”

Follow up from the roundtable on “Affordable Housing” in 2012 EAROPH Malaysia has set up a taskforce on Affordable Housing and the first taskforce meeting was held on 10th October 2012. The taskforce will address the issues and challenges and provide recommendation and input to the Government and relevant agencies on “Affordable Housing”. The programme was put on hold in early 2013.

However, the programme has been revived recently and another roundtable forum on “Affordable Housing” is proposed to be held by end of this year.

3.2 4R ENVIRONMENTAL CARE & COMMUNITY CARE PROGRAM IN SCHOOLS

EAROPH Malaysia together with Department of Media Studies, New Era College, Kajang has continued to organize the program for the fourth year running from 2011. The program is supported by Ministry of Housing and Local Government Malaysia. The program for last year’s themed FRESH ACTION Version 4.0.

The program was carried out from early August 2014 till end October 2015.

Participants will be from:

1. Internal - New Era College lecturers, students and staffs – Mentor
2. External(Main) - Kajang area secondary and primary school student–Mentee (6 schools)
- Kajang area school teachers
3. External(Secondary) - Kajang residents
- NGOs, PIBGs, RAs, Universities, Professional Bodies
- Local Authorities, Government
- All Malaysians

The program was officiated by the Ministry of Housing and Local Government Malaysia in 23rd of October 2014 and final exhibition and activities was from between 23rd to October – 25th of October 2014 at New Era College, Kajang, Selangor.

The same programme will be held this year from August to October 2015.

EAROPH Malaysia is planning to replicate this program at different cities/area with the CSR contribution from corporate companies.

3.3 GREEN SOLUTIONS FOR PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT (GSPD) 2011-2015

EAROPH Malaysia together with Real Estate and Housing Developers' Association (REDHA) Institute has organized this conference from 2010 till 2013.

However, we did not organise this event in 2014.

EAROPH Malaysia together with REDHA Institutes is proposing to have a day conference on “Green Living” in October 2015. As of previous years, this event will a Carbon Neutral event.

3.4 SAFE CITY PILOT PROJECT

EAROPH Malaysia has initiated Safe City Project since 2007 with selected Residents Association (RAs). As the feedback from RAs on safe city project are very slow, EAROPH Malaysia has taken different approach and program on safe city and will be partnering with MCPF to carry the Safe City Project.

3.5 WORLD HABITAT DAY 2014/2015

EAROPH Malaysia were involved in part of the World Habitat Day events organized by Ministry of Urban Well Being, Housing and Local Government Malaysia.
