Making Livable Community through Fence Removal City: Daegu Metropolitan City

Problems:

- Narrow paths in village
- High fence of the public buildings: Psychological barrier between public service providers and its customers (citizens)
- Ugly looks in old areas
- Poor communication among residents

Solutions

- Fence Removal Movement through private-public alliance
- Alliance of citizen, NGOs, professionals/planners for ‘Fence Removal Movement’.
- Fences of Public buildings (regional office, branch offices of government institutions, hospitals, schools, churches) were removed first, and then those of houses were removed on voluntary base..
- Street parks were provided along the widened paths
- All expenses were supported by public funds

Further Considerations

- Privacy
- Maintenance and management of trees and facilities in street parks
- Illegal parking and street vender problems
- Continuous supports by residents and local government were required.
